Tenant Resources

If you have an issue with your rental housing, first contact your landlord or community manager and follow up in writing, keeping a copy for your records. If the issue isn't resolved, reach out to the appropriate county agency below or use the online Community Complaint Form. If you're unsure who to contact, call Consumer Affairs.

CODE COMPLIANCE

- No heat (Oct 15 May 1) or air conditioning (May 15 - Oct 1)
- Gas, water, or electric problems
- Plumbing issues like leaks or sewage backup
- Broken doors, windows, wall, or structure damage
- Rats, mice, or insect infestations
- Unsafe stairways, walkways, or breezeways
- Construction or demolition done without permits
- Noise complaints (animals, construction, equipment)

PUBLIC WORKS AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES

- Overflowing trash, garbage, or recycling outside the dwelling
- Missed or mixed trash and recycling pick-ups by private haulers
- Bulk items, brush, or yard debris left near the curb for over 10 days
- Trash and recycling set out early or collected during prohibited hours (9 PM 6 AM)
